### ***Responsibilities of the Church Council include:***

a) Nurturing ministries of the congregation shall give attention to but not be limited to education, worship, Christian formation, membership care, small groups and stewardship. Attention must be given to the needs of individuals and families of all ages.

b) Outreach ministries of the church shall give attention to local and large community ministries of compassion, justice, and advocacy. These ministries include church and society, global ministries, higher education, and campus ministry, health and welfare, Christian unity and interreligious concerns, religion and race, and the status and role of women.

c) Witness ministries of the church shall give attention to developing and strengthening evangelistic efforts of sharing of personal and congregational stories of Christian experience, faith, and service; communications, lay speaking ministries, and other means that give expression of witness for Jesus Christ.

d) Leadership development and resourcing ministries shall give attention to the ongoing preparation and development of lay and clergy leaders for ministry of the church.

Members of the church conference shall be persons of genuine Christian character who love the church, are morally disciplined, are committed to the mandate of inclusiveness in the life of the church, are loyal to the ethical standards of The United Methodist Church ..., and are competent to administer its affairs. It shall include youth members ... All shall be members of the church (with the exception of the trustees).
